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Sermon Application Questions

- 1. How would you encourage someone who was waiting on God?
- 2. Why and how should we evangelize Jewish people?
- 3. What part of God's promise to David (2 Samuel 7) is most significant to you?
- 4. What are some reasons God might delay (at least from our perspective) fulfilling his promises?
- 5. How does verse 71 affect the way you should relate to hateful people? In what ways does this passage illustrate how we should love one another?
