

# REVISITING FAITH IN A PANDEMIC

Message Title: **The Reality of Death and the Hope of Deliverance**

Genesis 5:1-32 | Sunday AM, February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021 | Pastor Jack Lamb

**1** This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. **2** He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created. **3** And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a son in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth. **4** After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters. **5** So all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years; and he died. **6** Seth lived one hundred and five years, and begot Enosh. **7** After he begot Enosh, Seth lived eight hundred and seven years, and had sons and daughters. **8** So all the days of Seth were nine hundred and twelve years; and he died. **9** Enosh lived ninety years, and begot Cainan. **10** After he begot Cainan, Enosh lived eight hundred and fifteen years, and had sons and daughters. **11** So all the days of Enosh were nine hundred and five years; and he died. **12** Cainan lived seventy

years, and begot Mahalalel. **13** After he begot Mahalalel, Cainan lived eight hundred and forty years, and had sons and daughters. **14** So all the days of Cainan were nine hundred and ten years; and he died. **15** Mahalalel lived sixty-five years, and begot Jared. **16** After he begot Jared, Mahalalel lived eight hundred and thirty years, and had sons and daughters. **17** So all the days of Mahalalel were eight hundred and ninety-five years; and he died. **18** Jared lived one hundred and sixty-two years, and begot Enoch. **19** After he begot Enoch, Jared lived eight hundred years, and had sons and daughters. **20** So all the days of Jared were nine hundred and sixty-two years; and he died. **21** Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah. **22** After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters. **23** So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. **24** And Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him. **25** Methuselah lived one hundred and eighty-seven years, and begot Lamech. **26** After he begot Lamech, Methuselah lived seven hundred and eighty-two years, and had sons and daughters. **27** So all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred and sixty-nine years; and he died. **28** Lamech lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and had a son. **29** And he called his name Noah, saying, "This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed." **30** After he begot Noah, Lamech lived five hundred and ninety-five years, and had sons and daughters. **31** So all the days of Lamech were seven hundred and seventy-seven years; and he died. **32** And Noah was five hundred years old, and Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth.
