Ephesians 4:17-24 LSB | Sunday AM, May 29th, 2022 | Jack Lamb ¹⁷Therefore this I say, and testify in the Lord, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind, ¹⁸being darkened in their mind, alienated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart. ¹⁹And they, having become callous, have given themselves over to sensuality for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness. ²⁰But you did not learn Christ in this way—²¹if indeed you heard Him and were taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus—²²to lay aside, in reference to your former conduct, the old man, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, ²³and to be renewed in the spirit of your mind, ²⁴and to put on the new man, which in *the likeness of* God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.
